

## **2023 IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- If you were a member of JRCA in 2022, you do **NOT** need to send me a copy of your birth certificate, because I still have it. All new members **MUST** send in their birth certificate. All members must send in their w-9, and membership form as well. The w9 is on the member, not the parent. Make sure the membership form is notarized. This is mandatory.
  - *Return the w9 and birth certificate (if needed) with the Membership form.*
  - *It is required to have the Membership Form, birth certificate, and w9 turned in by the entry deadline of the first rodeo you plan to enter.*
- Some people like to pay for all their entry fees for the entire summer at the very beginning and that is fine. However, just keep in mind, that if you write ONE check for all the entry fees I will have to deposit it before the first rodeo. If you would like to turn all your entries in but write a SEPARATE check for each rodeo that is fine too. Those checks will be deposited before each individual rodeo. *This is a great way to take care of your paperwork ahead of time!*
- **Make separate checks for Membership Fees, \*Entry Fees, Stall & RV Reservations.**  
This helps me out with the books. Do not staple checks to forms.  
*\*Please write one check for both days of entry fees. If you have more than one child, write one check for all of their entry fees.*
- The Shoot-Out Rodeo will be in Childress this year. All-Around buckles will be given to a boy and girl in each age division. The buckles will be presented at the Canadian rodeo.
- You must compete at least 5 times in the events you participate in to qualify for the finals.
- 3 & under members that participate in ALL rodeos will receive a buckle at the Finals.
- I encourage all new members to read the Rulebook on the Home Page of our website. *Please take note of the Hat Fines/Broken Pattern Fines section. If you receive one of these, prompt payment is required. ☺*
- *Please take note of the Order of Events. We will begin at 8:00 a.m. each morning.*
- *Current Coggins will be required for EACH horse you bring with you to each rodeo, including those that will not be competed on during the rodeo (ie team ropings after the rodeo). Please submit a copy for the horses that you know you will be bringing when you send in your membership forms. Then, if further into the season, you bring other horses, you only have to submit the papers for those horses. I will keep these on file for the season.*
